## FLU VACCINATIONS 2023-24

### WHO CAN HAVE THE FREE FLU JAB?

Eligible groups for the 2023 to 2024 season:

- ◆ aged 2 and 3 years on 31 August 2023
- ◆ those aged 6 months to under 65 years in clinical risk groups
- ◆ pregnant women
- ◆ all those aged 65 years and over
- ◆ those in long-stay residential care homes
- ◆ carers, those in receipt of carer's allowance or main carer of an older or disabled person
- ◆ household contacts of immunocompromised individuals
- ◆ frontline health and social care staff

At the beginning of September we will be inviting Northlands patients that are eligible for a flu vaccination. All patients registered with a mobile number will be sent an invite via our clinical system (Systmone) which invites you to book your appointment by clicking on a link and inputting your date of birth. This is a trusted link being sent by the surgery. Please do not worry if you do not have or do not regularly use a mobile; we will call you. Alternatively you can book by calling the surgery on 01249 812141.

Patients are kindly requested to come 'jab-ready!', ie to ensure your time in the surgery is as brief as possible, please arrive on-time and wear a sleeveless or loose-fitting top. We will have a one-way system through the surgery in operation - marshals will help direct you to the right place.


