Flu Jabs for 50-64 year olds

Thank you to all our patients in at risk cohorts who have had their flu jab this season - we have had a brilliant uptake through September and October and administered close to 3,000 doses to date.

If you are in an at-risk group and have not yet had your jab, please contact us to arrange an appointment.

As you may be aware from the media, the Government has extended the national flu immunisation programme for 2020-21 to include 50-64 year olds who are not included in any at-risk cohort, subject to vaccine supply.

We have placed our first order for vaccines for this group and expect delivery at the end of November or early December. However, vaccine availability is subject to demand and delivery dates are yet to be confirmed as vaccinations cannot be offered until those most at risk have been vaccinated.

We hope to run a weekend clinic for 50-64 year olds on 5th or 12th December. As soon as we get the go-ahead to proceed, Northlands will text and phone eligible patients and appointments will be available online. Please check our website, Facebook page and Shout-Out Calne for updates.

Please note, flu clinics are socially distanced and patients are kindly requested to come 'Jab ready', ie to ensure your time in the surgery is as brief as possible, please arrive on time and wear a sleeveless or loose-fitting top, and a face covering (unless exempted) - thank you!



CHILD FLU VACCINATIONS STILL AVAILABLE ... at the surgery for children aged 2 and 3 years on 31 August 2020. All primary school aged children and those in Year 7 (aged 4 to 11 on 31 August 2020) receive the vaccination in school. At-risk children with long-term health conditions are also eligible for a free flu vaccination.
